12. Pecorino, Roccastella, Italy

A brilliant value for money, its power and complexity has led some Italians to describe wines made from the Pecorino grape as red wine dressed up as white. Perfect partner for white meats.

13. Gavi di Gavi, Fratelli Antonio Raimondo, Italy

£38.00

Traditional bone-dry Italian white. Made from the Cortese grape, it shows a touch of floral finish to add a touch of complexity.

14. Rioja Blanco, Bodegas Zugober, Spain

£28.00

Stylish white blossom aromatics and concentrated fruit flavours spiked with cinnamon. The palate is creamy and long. Oak ageing adds to the depth of flavor.

15. Albarino, Adegas Galegas, Rias Baixis, Galicia, Spain

£50.00

This region in north west Spain is well known for two things, wine and seafood, both of which go hand-in-hand with each other. A go to for an aperitif, or a perfect partner for like fish and seafood dishes. Plenty of acidity and fresh lemon & lime flavours to begin, with a more subtle finish, almost that of a grapefruit with a touch of basil.
