Gradually we have introduced some superb and not so widely recognised 'eclectics'; the Melodias Winemakers Selection Malbec from Argentina, or a stunning Cabernet Franc by Humberto Canale from Patagonia.

We have extended our selection of 'Fizz' and now feature the superbly fine Billecart-Salmon Brut Reserve alongside thirteen 'sparklers' two of which are very creditable English offerings from Nyetimber and Ridgeview from Sussex.

New additions this year sees a creditable range of English still wines, as well as sparkling wines, from top quality producers.

Our range of 12 wines by the glass plus Champagne, sparkling and dessert wines by the glass can all be found on their own page towards the end of the list.

The Bertani winery was founded in 1857 by the brothers Giovan Battista and Gaetano Bertani, in Quinto di Valpantena, north of Verona. Gaetano was an expert in the art of winemaking, having learnt new techniques in France from Professor Guyot, still considered a leading expert in viticulture today.

Bertani was one of the first companies in Italy to understand the value of bottled wine; huge investments were made to bottle and export all over the world. The quality of Bertani wine asserted itself straightaway for its elegance, so much so as that the Soave was on the menu at King George VI's coronation in England, in 1937.

In the middle of the twentieth century, Bertani put into effect the half-century long study to produce “the Wine”, made to last forever. This was the start of Amarone, the iconic wine from this area, with the first vintage dating back to 1958.
