AMARONE VALPANTENA Bertani, 2017, Veneto, Italy

Deep scents of cherry, sour cherry, berries and notes of spices. Soft in the mouth with flavours of red fruit.

The Bertani winery was founded in 1857 by the brothers Giovan Battista and Gaetano Bertani, in Quinto di Valpantena, north of Verona. Gaetano was an expert in the art of winemaking, having learnt new techniques in France from Professor Guyot, still considered a leading expert in viticulture today.

Bertani was one of the first companies in Italy to understand the value of bottled wine; huge investments were made to bottle and export all over the world. The quality of Bertani wine asserted itself straightaway for its elegance, so much so as that the Soave was on the menu at King George VI's coronation in England, in 1937.

In the middle of the twentieth century, Bertani put into effect the half-century long study to produce "the Wine", made to last forever. This was the start of Amarone, the iconic wine from this area, with the first vintage dating back to 1958.
