Gin Selection

London Dry Gins

Bombay Sapphire *Whitchurch, Hampshire* 40%

Every drop of Bombay Sapphire gin contains 10 hand-selected botanicals from exotic locations around the world, gently vapour infused to capture their bright, vibrant flavours. Botanicals include: juniper, lemon peel, coriander seeds, orris root, angelica root, bitter almonds, liquorice, cassia bark, cubeb berries, grains of paradise.

Chatsworth Small Batch Gin *Derbyshire* 40%

Selected botanicals from the Chatsworth garden & greenhouse have been used in the creation of this classic London Dry Gin. The infusion of Chatsworth lemons, lemongrass and lemon verbena produce a crisp citrus character which is complemented by the herbal notes of the banana leaf.

Hendricks *Scotland* 41.4%

A premium quality gin made with a blend of 11 botanicals and a unique infusion of rose petals and cucumber. Juniper is present along with the subtle notes of cucumber adding a fresh quality whilst the rose is most definitely present on the nose.

Masons Dry Yorkshire Gin *Bedale, North Yorkshire* 42%

A London Dry Gin using Harrogate spring water along with juniper, a combination of secret botanicals including citrus, spicy, slightly malty number has a pleasant fennel character.

Sir Robin of Locksley *Sheffield* 40%

A multi-purpose sipping gin that falls somewhere between a London Dry style and an Old Tom. Clean, yet rounded mouth feel, up-front juniper, delicate aromas of elderflower, warm cassia notes soothed with dandelion.

Shining Cliff Gin *Ambergate, Derbyshire* 45%

Award winning Derbyshire dry gin that is inspired by the woodland and hedgerows of Shining Cliff Woods. Crafted from thirteen botanicals including rose hip, bilberry & local mayflower. The spirit is delicately infused using vapour distillation to create a smooth, perfectly balanced Derbyshire dry gin. Awarded Silver at the San Francisco World Spirits Competition.

Monkey 47 *Black Forest, Germany* 47%

Batch distilled and handcrafted in Germany's Black Forest. In total, 47 handpicked plant ingredients prepared in extremely soft water lend Monkey 47 unrivalled complexity and quality.

Forest Distillery London Gin *Macclesfield, England* 42%

The only gin to win two separate double-gold medals at the San Francisco World Spirit Awards in the same year. Selected as one of the World's Best 50 Gins. Distilled in the heart of the Macclesfield Forest. Made in batches of 85 bottles at a time each bottle containing only the finest botanicals and water from our distillery spring.

Contemporary Gins

Brockmans *Woking, England* 40.0%

Distinctly different from the London Dry style. Marrying up beautifully with the blueberries and blackberries, this inspired combination, together with the dry, bittersweet Valencian oranges makes Brockmans a beautiful, intensely smooth gin.

Gin Mare *Vilanova, Costa Dorada, Spain* 42.7%

Gin Mare is made using traditional techniques from the Mediterranean, through a delicate maceration and independent distillation which expresses all the characteristics of each botanical in the final product. Botanicals including Arbequina olives, thyme, rosemary and basil give this Spanish gin a sophisticated Mediterranean flavour. Its slightly salty, more savoury flavour profile is great in a bloody mary.

The Botanist *Islay, Scotland* 46.0%

An exciting and unusual gin from Islay whisky distillery Bruichladdich, made in a Lomond still christened Ugly Betty it contains no fewer than 31 botanicals.

Flavoured Gins

Chatsworth Rose Pink Gin *Derbyshire* 40%

This truly luxurious botanical gin distilled on the Chatsworth Estate uses fresh scented roses from the Chatsworth gardens and distilled in short runs using a Holstein still to create a very special small batch gin. The rose petals are added to impart a subtle flavour with an exquisite aroma. The end result is a clear London Style Gin with no artificial pink colourings added. The perfume of roses is subtle but evident, with a slight sweet flavour.

Forest Distillery Earl Grey Gin *Macclesfield, England* 39.5%

Ingredients from the Macclesfield forest such as bilberry, wild raspberry, gorse flower, pine and moss, are ground by hand in a pestle & mortar with traditional gin ingredients, including Organic Juniper, Organic coriander seed, liquorice and vanilla. These freshly ground ingredients are then distilled just once in our tiny 30 litre pot still, before the addition of an incredible blend of Earl Grey Tea by Cheshire blenders Quinteessential, along with spring water from the ground beneath the distillery.

Peak Heritage, Hedgerow Harvest *Cuckoostone Distillery, Derbyshire* 42%

Distilled using key botanicals, which include blackberry, raspberry, bilberry and crab apples all sourced from the Peak District. This gin is blended and infused over seven days to create an indulgent berry flavour and a rose pink hue. The result is a smooth dry gin bursting with fruity flavours whilst keeping the warm earthy bottom notes that Peak Heritage is famous for.

Shining Cliff Bakewell Pud Gin *Ambergate, Derbyshire* 45%

A Derbyshire dry gin with subtle cherry and almond flavours, inspired by the famous local Bakewell pud. Distilled from nine botanicals, including English cherries, raspberries, toasted flaked almonds and vanilla, and then macerated in cherries to lift the fruit notes and give a pink hue.

Saxton Cooper Blood Orange *Cuckoostone Distillery, Derbyshire* 37.5%

Rich with orange & citrus flavour. A beautifully lush & smooth gin with a hint of sweetness on the finish.

Saxton Cooper Grapefruit *Cuckoostone Distillery, Derbyshire* 37.5%

Rich with fresh citrus flavour.

Saxton Cooper Rhubarb & Ginger *Cuckoostone Distillery, Derbyshire* 37.5%

Rich with the flavour of English rhubarb.

Saxton Cooper Sicilian Lemon *Cuckoostone Distillery, Derbyshire* 37.5%

Rich with the flavour of juniper & citrus

Warner Edwards Rhubarb *Harrington, Northamptonshire* 40%

Inspired by a crop of rhubarb originally grown in Queen Victoria's own kitchen garden, hints of black pepper, cardamom, cinnamon and of course plenty of Rhubarb

Whitley Neill, Raspberry *London 42%*

An initial and distinct juniper, coriander flavour, gives way to a bright, fresh vibrant taste of Scottish raspberries. A perfectly balanced Gin with a delicate, fruity taste and a lasting citrus, raspberry flavour.

Warner Edwards Elderflower *Harrington Northamptonshire 40%*

Harvested just once a year each bottle is infused with over 200 elderflowers from the farm's local hedgerows. A delicately sweet and floral gin.

Non-Alcoholic Gins

Tanqueray Alcohol Free 0.0 *Cameron Bridge Distillery, Edinburgh*

This gorgeous alcohol-free spirit is created by distilling the same botanicals used in Tanqueray London Dry Gin. They are individually immersed in water, heated and then distilled before being expertly blended together to capture the essence of Tanqueray in a delicious alcohol-free alternative.

Pearson's Botanicals combines fine Scottish waters to blend this premier citrus tasting alcohol-free drink based on a classic Pink Gin. A Tart based Gin alternative with Sharp Rhubarb and Warm Ginger marry perfectly with Juniper and Cassia for the perfect experience. A pleasing combination of sharp & sweet, with the body and heat of ginger. The complementary classic juniper gin signatures orchestrate a melody of flavour notes just waiting on the sparkle of the tonic. A floral based Gin alternative with Heady Hibiscus and Rose back notes float over the quintessential classic London Dry flavours.

Warner Edwards Pink Berry 0% Gin *Harrington Northamptonshire*

Fruity bursts of raspberry & blackcurrant sage, spicy Szechuan pepper, ginger and chilli, all work together to give this 0% spirit the recognisable 'kick' of a top shelf tippie.



whisky

[*hwis-kee*] noun

distilled nectar originating in Scotland. Gold in colour with the perfect mixture of storytelling, singing and a pleasant burning sensation.

Malt Selection

Single Malts

Dalwhinnie *Dalwhinnie, Scotland* 43%

Smooth, soft and lasting flavours of heather-honey sweetness and vanilla followed by deeper citrus-fruit flavours and hints of malted bread. Long, lingering, surprisingly intense finish that starts sweetly, then gives way to smoke, peat and malt.

Glenfiddich 12 Year Old *Dufftown, Scotland* 40%

Characteristic sweet, fruity notes. Develops into butterscotch, cream, malt and subtle oak flavours. Distinctively fresh and fruity nose with a hint of pear. Beautifully crafted and delicately balanced.

The Glanlivet *Ballindalloch, Scotland* 40%

Creamy sweetness and zesty fruits taste mix with a citrus fruit and sweet orange nose, giving a long, creamy and smooth finish.

Glenmorangie Original 10 Year Old *Tain, Scotland* 40%

A smooth whisky which welcomes you with a rush of citrus, then holds your attention with layers of luscious flavour, from orange to honey and creamy vanilla, with bursts of peach.

Jura *Isle of Jura, Scotland* 40%

Copper gold in colour, with a nose of vanilla, orange, cracked black pepper and dark chocolate. Taste of nectarines, ginger, coffee and toasted almonds, matured in American White ex bourbon barrels for 10 years and finished in Oloroso sherry casks from Jerez, Spain.

Laphroaig 10 *Islay, Scotland* 40%

Laphroaig 10 gets its distinctive taste from the natural features of Islay, the remote and rugged island off the West Coast of Scotland where the whisky is made. Local water is sourced from the legendary Kilbride Stream, and the malted barley is cold-smoked then dried over a fire fuelled by the Islay peat. This lends a distinctive flavour that speaks of the land where it was forged.

Talisker 10 *Isle of Skye, Scotland* 45.8%

A rich dried-fruit sweetness with clouds of smoke and strong barley-malt flavours, warming and intense. At the back of the mouth is an explosion of pepper.

Wireworks Small Batch *Ambergate, Derbyshire* 47.7%

A complex, approachable single malt whisky in our lightly-peated core house style. Vanilla butter fudge, green apples and fruitcake on the nose, with tobacco, bitter orange marmalade and cereal on the palate, with smoke and spice on the finish, fading to a sweet vanilla.

Wireworks Virgin Oak Finish *Ambergate, Derbyshire* 51.7%

Caramelised sugar, leather and apples on the nose, good mouthfeel with pepper and fruit flavours on the palate and a smoky-sweet clove finish.

Blended Malts

Famous Grouse *Perthshire, Scotland* 40%

Smooth and perfectly balanced. Scotland's favourite blend of the finest malts and exceptional grain whiskies.

Forest Whisky Blend Number Twenty Seven *Macclesfield, England* 47%

Distilled Cheshire Barley & Oats with wild yeast and spring water which is then matured in Oak below the Cat & Fiddle pub for 3 years, before being blended with other selected whiskies. A final, sumptuous stage of flavour was then added, by resting the blend in a 50 year old Oloroso cask. The result is a delicious smooth whisky with a light sweetness of the very highest quality.

Jameson *Dublin, Ireland* 40%

The perfect balance of spicy, nutty and vanilla notes with hints of sweet sherry and exceptional smoothness.

Johnnie Walker Black Label *Edinburgh, Scotland* 40%

Blended to perfection, Johnnie Walker Black Label is a rich, smooth Scotch Whisky made using only single malt and grain whiskies from more than 29 distilleries spending 12 years in a cask growing into a vibrant body of flavour. The result is deep layers of sweet fruit, spice and vanilla – all wrapped in a cloak of smoke. Ideally served in a tall glass as a highball with the mixer of your choice, like lemonade, ginger ale or peach iced tea, for an electric burst of bite and flavours.

Rum Selection

Dark Rum

Mount Gay, Eclipse Heritage Blend *Barbados, Caribbean* 40%

Eclipse is the embodiment of the Mount Gay style, body and aroma by which our Master Blender Trudiann Branker uses to blend every variety of Mount Gay Rum. For many rum aficionados Eclipse is also the reference by which all rum should be measured.

White Peak Distillery Cask Aged Rum *Ambergate, Derbyshire* 45%

A rum to savour. Aged for a minimum of 12 months in oak, principally an ex-Port cask, the rum has a real depth of flavour and complexity, all coming from the as distilled spirit.

Spiced Rum

Kraken *Caribbean* 40%

Named for the sea beast of myth and legend, The Kraken is bold, rich, black and smooth. The largest shipment of Caribbean black spiced rum was said to be brought down by the Kraken. The rum was named in its honour, as it was as dark and mysterious as the beast's ink

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
